Summary

In this role, you will be responsible for overseeing the work of ASI's Vehicle independent Inspectors at a fixed-site third-party facility. You will audit their work and perform inspections when time permits. As well as do photo audits, training, and Lot operation functions that your manager asks you to do daily. Inspections are performed in compliance with the client's inspection routine and guidelines. The Auction Inspection Lead may also have to work cooperatively with our site customer(s) and other vendors, or contractors assigned to the facility. This role is for you if you have a keen eye for detail, are looking for a position where you can use your communication skills, and are willing to be out and about leading, training, and inspecting vehicles during daylight and in all weather conditions.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordinate the scheduling of work for inspectors to ensure compliance with client service level agreements, auction sale-day schedules, and other location specific operational requirements.
- Actively engages with auction departments within the operating location and ASI Inspection management
- Clearly communicates responsibilities and expectations to vendors, documents attendance, and assists vendors meeting performance objectives for both quality and quantity of work.
- Ensures employee compliance with customer policy (SLA) and procedures and location policies and processes.
- Provides support of equipment and supply inventories.
- Completes physical audits as prescribed by ASI Inspections QA Program.
- Provides motivation, feedback, coaching and guidance to inspection vendors
- Assists with reviews on arbitrated vehicles, damage verification requests, etc.
- Provide input and feedback to Inspection Manager regarding all things Vendor Group
